Description:

Coronado TDH tall fescue was developed by Pure-Seed Testing, Inc. It is a dark green cultivar with excellent drought tolerance. Coronado TDH requires less water to stay green longer than other tall fescues under drought stress. Coronado TDH has good heat tolerance and resistance to brown patch, gray leaf spot, net blotch, stem rust, and crown rust.

Applications:

Coronado TDH is adapted for lawns, golf course roughs, cemeteries, parks, sod production, sports fields, roadsides and slope stabilization. Its drought tolerance makes Coronado TDH especially well-suited for residential or commercial lawns and low-maintenance turf areas. Coronado TDH performs well in sun or shade.

Geographical Adaption:

Coronado TDH performs well in the Transition Zone and temperate climates. It is adapted to a wide range of soil types and pH. Recommended seeding rate is 5-8 lb/1000 ft2 (245-390 kg/ha). Fertilize at 3-5 lb N/1000 ft2/yr (145-245 kg/ha); mow at 1.5-3.0" (4-8 cm); irrigate deeply and infrequently.
