### Variety information

**Description:**

Cumberland tall fescue was developed by Pure-Seed Testing, Inc. It is a bright, medium-green cultivar with excellent summer turf performance. Cumberland maintains its bright green color and density during hot, humid summers. Cumberland has outstanding heat tolerance and resistance to brown patch, gray leaf spot, net blotch, stem rust, and crown rust.

**Applications:**

Cumberland is adapted for lawns, golf course roughs, cemeteries, parks, sod production, sports fields, roadsides and slope stabilization. Its drought tolerance makes Cumberland especially well suited for residential or commercial lawns and low-maintenance turf areas. Cumberland performs well in sun or shade.

**Geographical Adaption:**

Cumberland performs well in the Transition Zone and temperate climates. It is adapted to a wide range of soil types and pH. Recommended seeding rate is 5-8 lbs/1000 ft<sup>2</sup> (245-390 kg/ha). Fertilize at 3-5 lbs N/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>/yr (145-245 kg/ha); mow at 1.5-3.0" (4-8 cm); irrigate deeply and infrequently
